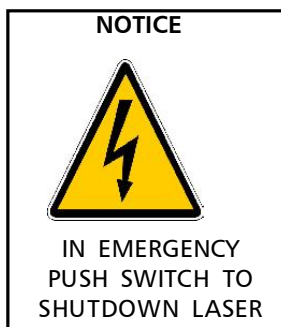

A storm is a disturbance of the ordinary conditions of the atmosphere accompanied by wind, rain, snow, sleet, hail (frozen rain), or thunder and lightning. Types of storms include the extra tropical cyclone, the common, large-scale storm of temperate latitudes; the tropical cyclone, or hurricane, which is somewhat smaller in area than the former and accompanied by high winds and heavy rains; the tornado, or "twister", a small but intense storm with very high winds, usually of limited duration; and the thunderstorm, local in nature and accompanied by brief but heavy rain showers and often by hail. The term storm is also applied to blizzards, sandstorms, and dust storms, in which high wind is the dominant meteorological element.

### HOW TO MAKE EPE BANANA



Ingredients:

- 1 bunch of "kepok" bananas (not too ripe)
- 1 liter of water
- 1 kilogram brown sugar
- 50 grams white sugar
- 10 vanilla essences

Step:

- Peel the banana, and then roast them over charcoal until somewhat soft and brown.
- Flatten them with a special wooden clamp or, if you don't own one, use large flat wood spoon to flatten the bananas on a cutting board.
- Sauce: boil the water with the brown sugar, white sugar and vanilla essence until it dissolve into thick syrup, then pour over the bananas.
